## LSL GUIDELINES FOR RESTARTING FIXTURES FOR HOSTS AND VISITORS

(Official LSL matched fixtures - subject to Government restrictions in force)

May 2021

## **Primary guidelines:**

- a. All players are post -14 days full vaccination and in general good health when attending fixtures.
- b. Any problems arising with meeting guidelines can be referred back the LSL committee or Covid liaison contacts. (Philip Cohen or Mauro Pratesi)
- c. If at any time someone in your household gets Covid you should pause hosting and visiting immediately and advise the LSL committee/Covid liaison contacts as soon as possible. (confidentiality will be observed).
- d. For those not vaccinated there would be an option to have a free lateral flow test 24 hours before, and after, attending or hosting any fixture.

## Host guidelines:

- 1. Ensure playing materials are hygienic as practically possible.
- 2. Provide the means for visitors to wash their hands on arrival.
- 3. Provide hand sanitiser gel for visitors in the playing area.
- 4. Ensure ventilation in the playing area when possible (but don't let your guests freeze)
- 5. If a player turns up with cold or flu symptoms you can exercise the discretion to ask them not to play or at the very least to wear a mask.
- 6. Host has the final decision on health and hygiene but should apply any requests tactfully.

## Visitor guidelines:

- 1. Do not attend a fixture if you have new symptoms of temperature, cough or cold/flu. Notify the host ASAP to make alternative arrangements.
- 2. Wash your hands on arrival, the host will expect this and make provisions.
- 3. You can ask for the playing area to be better ventilated if this has not happened and as long as the outdoor air temperature is comfortable for all.
- 4. You do not need to wear a mask to play unless
  - a. you choose to or
  - b. the host asks you to because you have some mild respiratory symptoms.
- 5. The host has the final say on health and hygiene, please be patient with any requirements you are asked to fulfill.
